This position is classified as OES/SOC 19-3011, Research Assistant (Economics).

Assist the Head of Policy and Creator in Residence ensure completion of economic research projects; research and summarize various components of technology and innovation policy at the federal and state level to support the organization's policy team, Head of Policy, and Creator in Residence; attend economics events, hearings, and other opportunities to better inform strategy and represent the organization; support team operations; write short-form and co-authored longer pieces on relevant economics topics; occasional travel is required.
